The Distinguished Business Leader Award (DBLA) recognizes one remarkable individual in the Calgary community who exemplifies outstanding leadership, business acumen and service to the community.

The DBLA is co-sponsored by the Haskayne School of Business and the Calgary Chamber of Commerce.

Confidentiality: All submissions received will be kept confidential.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria: Each nominee should exemplify leadership, business acumen, commitment to management education and community service. To be eligible for the award, the nominee must:

- have proven leadership skills;
- have exceptional achievement in business;
- have made a significant contribution to the community;
- be a member of the Calgary Chamber of Commerce; and
- have demonstrated engagement with and/or service to the Haskayne School of Business. (Examples of eligible activities are provided on Page 9.)

Expectations of the Award Recipient: The candidate selected to receive the award must be willing to participate in and speak at three related events:

- the 2011 Distinguished Business Leader Award Gala (mid-May);
- the 2012 Business Day Conference organized by the Haskayne School of Business Commerce Undergraduate Society (early February); and,
- the 2012 Distinguished Business Leader Award Gala to introduce the 2012 recipient and present the award.
