The code for Mathison Hall is MTH. The closest public flat-rate parking lot is Lot 32. Please note accessible parking is available at the <u>loop</u> in front of the Mathison Hall Main Entrance. These spots are indicated on the picture of the map at the end of this document.

Day 1: August 31, 2023. Orientation Check-in will be at 9:00 am.

Orientation Check-in will be on the main floor (level 2) of Mathison Hall. This space is called the Robert G. Peters Floor and is visible from the main doors into Mathison Hall. There will be signage and people to direct you. Please arrive for Orientation Check-in at 9:00 am to be introduced to your orientation groups. At check-in, you will be assigned to a small group of approximately 30 students and an Orientation Leader. This day is organized by the Central Orientation team. Day 2: September 1, 2023. Orientation Check-in will be at 9:00 am.

Orientation Check-in will be on the main floor (level 2) of Mathison Hall. This space is called the Robert G. Peters Floor and is visible from the main doors into Mathison Hall. Haskayne Orientation activities will occur simultaneously throughout our time together, and you can do most of them in whatever order you like. However, the Student Service presentation will multiple times and students will attend based on a predetermined schedule. Your orientation leader will be there to guide you and give you suggestions. Gender-Inclusive Washrooms

Haskayne has Gender-Inclusive washrooms in **Mathison Hall**. When you enter the washroom, you will see a communal sink area and private stalls. There is one accessible stall and change table in each washroom. **Scurfield Hall** has gender-exclusive and gender-neutral washrooms (gender-neutral washrooms are separate, private, single-stalled washrooms).
