

Q 1. Can I still participate in Co-op as an international student?

Q 3. Will my work terms have to be completed in Canada, or can I complete a work term in my home country/internationally?

Most of our Co-op placements are in Calgary. In fact, our connection to the local Calgary business community is a huge advantage for our Co-op students. However, you can complete a work placement outside of Calgary, assuming it qualifies as a Co-op work placement and is relevant to your career goals

Before accepting, please make sure to connect with a CDS (Career Development Specialists) to be sure that this placement qualifies.
