Change starts here. Support the growth of tomorrow's business leaders through meaningful learning opportunities.

Our goal is to raise \$3 million to rapidly expand work-integrated learning initiatives. We are seeking individual and corporate supporters to enable more real-world projects that benefit Haskayne and our communities, particularly students and employers. Current areas for philanthropic investment include:

> Creating and growing our co-op and internship programs.

The program is based on a "traditional" four-month internship model but is flexible in design to accommodate and fulfill stakeholder and student needs. Currently, approximately 30 per cent of eligible students participate in formal co-op and internship programs each year. Our goal is to reach 50 per cent participation.

> Expanding the Propel Business Project Program offering.

Complimenting the "traditional" work-integrated learning programs, these are micro-internships focused on start-ups, incubators and small and medium-sized not-for-profit organizations and can include a combination of on-location and remote work at local, domestic and international locations. These internships allow students and employers to co-create meaningful work experiences. This program has expanded Haskayne's reach in our communities and has allowed us to forge new partnerships with diverse organizations. Currently, we offer the program to students in the Master of Management and MBA programs. Our goal is to make this program available to all Haskayne students.

> Building work integrated learning into every Haskayne program.

We aim to embed formalized work-integrated learning curriculum into all of Haskayne's programs, starting with Master of Management and MBA, with the optimal goal of having internship programming in place for all Haskayne students.
