ADMISSIONS

Applicants for the Alberta Haskayne Executive MBA are evaluated based on thoughtful consideration as to how the program will help them achieve their professional goals and how the rest of the cohort will benefit from their participation.

The quality of the Executive MBA experience is critically dependent on the diversity and character of the cohort. The admissions committee therefore considers a wide range of factors in its admission decisions and views each applicant from a holistic perspective.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for admission to the Alberta Haskayne Executive MBA, an application should fulfill one of the following three sets of criteria:

- 1. A GPA of 3.0 (out of 4.0) or higher in the last two years of a four-year undergraduate degree, graduate degree or professional degree (e.g. Medicine, Law) from an accredited university AND at least seven years progressive work experience; **OR**
- 2. A GPA of less than 3.0 (out of 4.0) in a university degree as described above AND at least seven years progressive work experience AND a score of 500 or higher in the GMAT exam; **OR**
- 3. At least ten years progressive work experience AND a score of 500 or higher in the GMAT exam.

Applicants for whom English is not a first language must also achieve either:

- A score of 97 or higher on the internet version of the TOEFL; **OR**
- A score of 7 or higher on the academic version of the IELTS.
