<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Transfer students complete their pre-commerce year outside of the BComm program and apply for entry into Year 2 of the program.</li> <li>The BComm program is comprised of a certain number of non-commerce options to fill breadth requirements, and these cannot be substituted with additional commerce courses .</li> <li>Transfer students must complete all 18 units of pre-commerce prerequisite courses with a grade of C- or better by the end of the Winter term the year of admission, meet a competitive GPA, and application deadlines. Admission GPA is calculated using the most recent course work to maximum of 30 units.</li> <li>Students completing a combined degree program or minor program will fill the majority of their junior and senior options with required courses for their combined degree or minor program.</li> <li>Students will select or change their concentration in Year 2 (for Year 3), after completing the majority of their senior core courses.</li> <li>Students are eligible to apply for the co-operative education program if they have completed 30 units. Co-op students must complete 54 units, including MGST 217, SGMA 217, ACCT 217 and ENTI 317 before their first work term. Co-op students will also complete Co-op 523.01 and Co-op 523.02.</li> <li>Students are eligible to apply for the BComm honours program if they are completing 48 units, including MGST 217, SGMA 217, STAT 213, STAT 217, ENTI 317 and MGST 391. Honours students will complete MGST 301, MGST 501, and MGST 503 in lieu of three senior option courses in their program.</li> <li>A grade of D or D+ is permitted in up to 12 units of option courses.</li> <li>A minimum grade of C- is required in concentration, prerequisite, core, commerce, and honours courses.
