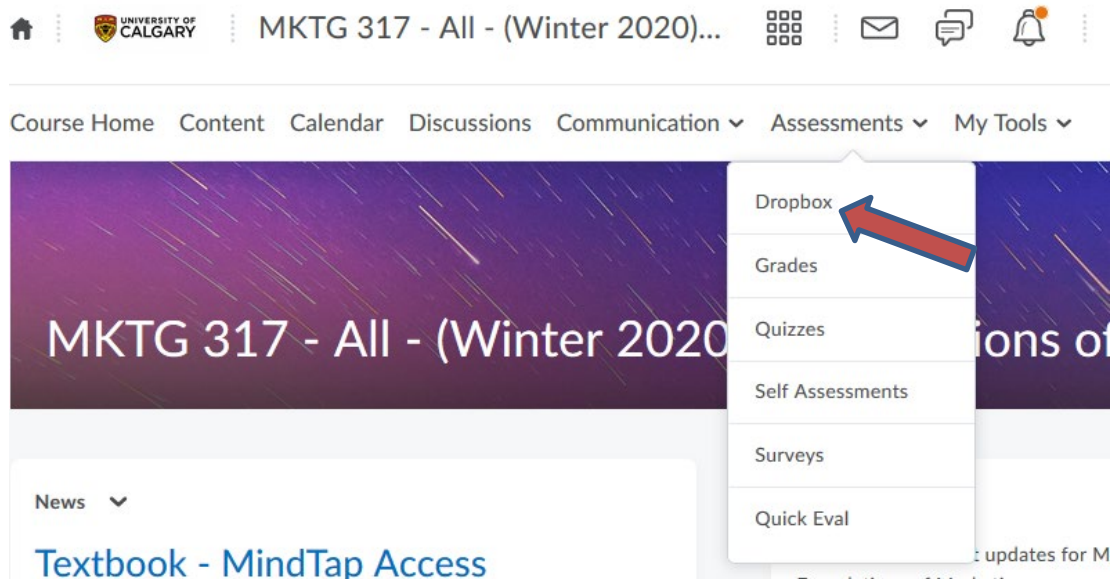


## For students - How to Upload Videos or Large files to Dropbox

1. Sign into D2L and navigate to your course site. Note: D2L supports up to **2GB per file**.
2. Go to Assessments → Dropbox



3. Click on the name of your assignment Dropbox folder. You will see the screen below. Click “add a file.”
