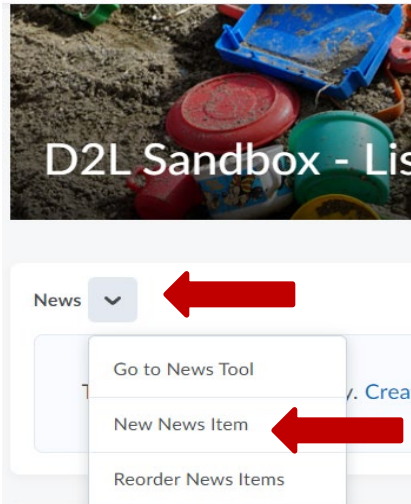


How to Create a News Item in D2L

1. From your D2L course home page, click the News dropdown menu and select “New News Item”.

2. You will be taken to a new screen. Compose your news item with a headline and content text. You can also scroll down to include attachments if you wish. When the news item is finished, click the blue “Publish” button. You can also save as a draft if you’d like to wait a bit before posting

This can be a problem when copying directly from Word or PowerPoint to author D2L news items, email or instructions in a text window. The Microsoft code tends to conflict with how D2L is set to render standard HTML.
