How to Import Grades to your Gradebook with a CSV File

1. In your class's D2L site, click **"Assessments"** in the navigation bar and then in the drop-down menu select **"Grades"** to open the Gradebook

4. Click on "Choose File", then – locate the CSV file that you previously exported and saved. Select that file for import. When your file has been uploaded then click "Continue". NOTE: There is a SAMPLE of a file located above the "Continue" button in D2L for your reference
